## "WHEN 3 X 7 = 1"

## 7 SIGNS, 7 DESCRIPTIONS & 7 STATEMENTS THAT LEAD TO 1 CONCLUSION!

The purpose of the writing of the Gospel of John is clearly stated in Jn. 20:30-31: "But these are written, that you might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name." John wanted the readers of his gospel to understand who Jesus Christ truly was i.e. God in human flesh! To accomplish that John assembled an impressive array of evidences to convince any openminded person of that truth, with the ultimate hope that they would be compelled to believe on Jesus Christ and thus obtain salvation.

The word "believe" is THE key word which runs throughout the entire book of John.<sup>2</sup> It means far more than mere intellectual assent to a few facts. To "believe" is to exclusively "trust in," "cling to," & "rely on" on someone or something. A well-known example of genuine "belief" occurred at Niagara Falls in 1860. There the tight rope walker "Blondin" challenged the large crowd who had gathered & had watched him walk across that fearful gorge safely. He asked them, "Who believes I can return to the other side with a man on my back?" The crowd roared their assent & many raised their hands. But when he began asking those who had raised their hands indicating they believed he could do it to get on his back & go, all declined until finally one man agreed to climb on his back and trust Blondin to carry him across safely—which he did! Many said they "believed" Blondin could do it, but only one truly believed since he alone put his life on the line and was carried across! This is the kind of commitment or belief in Jesus Christ which John sought to produce in his readers via three powerful sets of evidences in his gospel:

- 1. SEVEN SIGNS THAT JESUS PERFORMED i.e. Miracles that He did.
- **A.** <u>Changing water into wine</u> **2:1-11**. Christ instantly created what would normally have taken an entire year (or more) to produce.<sup>3</sup>
- **B.** <u>Healing of the royal official's</u> (Centurion's) <u>son</u> **4:46-54**. Power over impending death... and an example of true saving faith!
- C. <u>Healing of the invalid at Bethesda</u> **5:1-18**. Power over physical defect/disease. (Possibly paralysis?) A clear, bold claim that He was equal with God the Father! (vv. 17-18)
- D. <u>Feeding of the 5000</u> 6:1-14. Power over creation. The only miracle contained in all 4 Gospels. The high point of his ministry, since the Jews believed that Messiah would come during Passover and that He would perform a miracle of feeding the people miraculously, like Moses did with the manna in the wilderness! The Dead Sea Scrolls even contains seating instructions for this event! (Robert Gundry)

<sup>2</sup> "The one key word that clearly dominates the Gospel of John is the word "believe" [cf. "believeth," "believes," "believed," "did not believe," "do not believe," etc.]. The word[s] occur an amazing number of times throughout John's gospel, appearing in every chapter except chapters 15, 18 & 21! [e.g. 1:12, 50; 2:22, 23; 3:12, 15, 16, 18 [3 times], 36 [twice]; 4:21, 39, 41, 42, 48, 50, 53; 5:24, 44, 46 [twice], 47 [twice]; 6:29, 30, 35, 36, 40, 47, 64, 69; 7:5, 38, 39, 48; 8:24, 30, 31, 45; 9:18, 35, 36, 38; 10:25, 37, 38 [3 times], 42; 11:15, 26, 27, 40, 42, 45, 48; 12:11, 36, 39, 42, 44, 46, 47; 13:19; 14:1 [twice], 10, 11 [twice], 12, 29; 16:9, 27, 30, 31; 17:8, 20, 21; 19:35; 20:8, 25, 27, 29 [twice], 31 [twice]." <sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Note: The word "wine" in Scripture refers to several different things including alcoholic wine, fresh pressed grape juice, grapes still growing on the vine & preserved non-alcoholic grape juice (btw: the ancients had several ways of doing that). So one should not jump to erroneous conclusions! I do not believe Jesus Christ made or drank alcoholic wine! Instead, I am persuaded, based on the evidence contained in the Word of God as well as a consideration of His holy & divine character as God, that in this miracle Jesus created the most exquisite, fresh grape juice. For a thorough study & review of the evidence regarding this subject, please see my paper "Wine and Alcohol in the Bible" (25pp) or the abridged 12 page version. -mwe

- E. Walking on the sea 6:16-21. Power over nature!
- **F.** <u>Restoration of sight</u> **9:1-41.** Power over physical defects!
- G. Raising of Lazarus from the dead 11:1-44. Power over DEATH! cf. Heb. 2:14-15.
- **2.** <u>SEVEN DESCRIPTIONS THAT JESUS GAVE OF HIMSELF</u> i.e. Personifications that He gave.
- A. "I Am the Bread of Life" John 6:35. Key words in this passage: "Believe" "Eternal Life" "Comes" & "Bread." vv. 1-25 are all about physical bread while vv. 26-65 are all about spiritual bread.
- B. "I Am <u>the Light of the World</u>" John 8:12. cf. background of the Feast of Tabernacles & the Feast of Lights. See Alfred Edersheim, "Jesus the Messiah" [pp. 589-ff] which explains how Christ by His actions was claiming to be God and the way to heaven.
- C. "I Am the Door of the Sheepfold" John 10:7, 9. Shepherds often laid down in the opening of the sheepfold and became a "living" door!
- D. "I Am the Good Shepherd" John 10:11, 14. Unlike a hireling or a fake, he was willing to give his very life for the sheep!
- E. "I Am the Resurrection and the Life" John 11:25. "I am the resurrection and the life; he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: and whosoever lives and believes in me shall never die. Do you believe this?"
- F. "I Am the Way, the Truth and the Life" John 14:6. Note the context: vv. 1-5: "Let not your heart be troubled: you believe in God, believe also in me...I go to prepare a place for you...we don't know where you're going and how can we know the way?"
- G. "I Am the True Vine" John 15:1, 5. If you know Christ, we need to learn to "abide" in Him at all times.
- 3. <u>SEVEN CLAIMS THAT JESUS MADE ABOUT HIMSELF</u> i.e. Statements that He made.
- A. "I Am" John 4:26 "I that speak unto thee am he"
- B. "I Am" John 8:24 "If ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins"
- C. "I Am" John 8:28 "When ye have lifted up the Son of Man, then shall ye know that I am he"
- D. "I Am" John 8:58 "Before Abraham was, I am"
- E. "I Am" John 13:19 "...that when it is come to pass, ye may believe that I am he"
- F. "I Am" John 18:5-6 "Jesus saith unto them, I am he... As soon then as he had said unto them, I am he, they went backward and fell to the ground."
- G. "IAm" Jn. 18:8 "Jesus answered, 'I have told you that I am he...'
