BIBLE ACTION TRUTHS for MARRIED LOVE and a HAPPY MARRIED LIFE¹

- 1. MARRIAGE IS BASED ON THE CHARACTER OF THE PARTICIPANTS Eph. 5:14-19
 - a) A born-again Christian Eph. 5:14; John 3
 - b) A Spirit-filled Christian Eph. 5:18-19; Gal. 5:22-23

Spiritual life affects married love, and married love affects the spiritual life. Married love is a perfect example of the believer's relationship with Christ.

- 2. <u>LOVE</u>: An unselfish or self-sacrificing desire to meet the needs of the cherished object. (It's) a mental attitude. I Cor. 13:4-7, 11 –from childish to mature, holy love.
 - a) Involves:
 - 1) Understanding the partner's needs Prov. 17:27; 14:1
 - Women: Communication, Security & Homemaking
 - Men: Ego and Physical (food and love)
 - 2) Giving: The circle of love II Cor. 9:6-8; Luke 6:38

 If children don't learn to love at home, they find it very hard to love people.
 - b) Love is TLC:

Spiritual Mental & Emotional Physical

<u>T</u>ender telling <u>L</u>oving in little things <u>C</u>are in your contact

- c) Communication Eph. 4:22-32
 - 5 Rules:
 - $\mathbf{v.} \ \mathbf{25} Be \ open \ and \ honest.$
 - vv. 26-27 Talk up instead of blow up or clam up.
 - **v. 28** *Be industrious. Take full share of responsibilities.*
 - $\mathbf{v.29} Edify\ by\ what\ \&\ how\ you\ speak.$
 - vv. 30-32 Forgive with a kind, tenderhearted spirit (I Cor. 13:4)
- d) Rejoice and give thanks in everything Eph. 5:19-20; I Thess. 5:18. What for? (Rom. 8:28; John 10:10). Are you enjoying the abundant life? How? (Ps. 107:8) Praise the Lord seven times a day (Ps. 119:164).
- 3. <u>DUTY OF THE WIFE</u>: <u>Submission and Obedience</u>—loses freedom but gains the benefits of security and protection Eph. 5:22-24
 - a) Eph. 5:22-24 God's rank of authority.
 - **b)** I Pet. 3:1-6 To develop inner beauty; meek and quiet spirit.

I Tim. 2:9-10 – Modest and discreet with good works.

Titus 2:4-5 – Obey; teach to be obedient.

- c) I Cor. 14:34 & I Tim. 2:11-15 (Women are not to preach, pastor churches, etc.)
- d) I Cor. 11:3, 7-12 Woman was created for the man.
- e) Gen. 3:16 Result of God's curse—"he will rule over thee."

f) Checklist for wives:

- 1) Are you submissive and obedient?
- 2) Do you have inner beauty?
- *3) Will you pray for your husband every day?*

4. <u>DUTY OF THE HUSBAND</u>: <u>Love & Leadership</u>—"husbands love your wives" – Eph. 5:25-29

- a) As Christ loved the church. As you love your own body.
- b) Don't be bitter against her (Col. 3:19; Prov. 18:22) cf. Eph. 4:26-27, 31 Anger—I Cor. 14:20
- c) **Bitterness**:
- 1) Creates negative mental attitudes resulting in bickering and belittling.
- 2) Interrupts communication—indifference.
- 3) Kills warm, emotional feelings—coldness.
- d) Love & meeting the needs of his wife (affection & security). Keeps husband from being dictatorial I **Pet. 3:7**

e) Checklist for husbands:

- 1) Do you tear down instead of build up your wife?
- 2) Do you disagree with your wife's discipline of children?
- 3) Do you buy and use the car without her knowledge?
- 4) Do you make your wife beg for money?
- 5) Do you plan the family vacation yourself?
- f) It takes two to make a marriage and two to break a marriage.

5. ONE FLESH—the physical relationship – Eph. 5:31-32

Eph. 5:31 – "leave father and mother"—family interference breaks up marriage

Join or "cleave" – glued together (original Greek meaning). Matt. 19:5-6; Mark 10:6-8; Gen. 2:24 – "one" is the same Hebrew word used in Deut. 6:4. Note the contrast in A, B, and C below: In marriage *ONLY*, the one-flesh relationship is God-ordained and honorable. God hates sex outside of marriage.

- a) **Heb. 13:4** It's honorable, the bed is undefiled
 - **Psalm 51:5** This does not teach that the physical relationship as sin. Hebrew parallelism of verses 2-3, 7 i.e. the sin nature passes on at conception.
- b) **Prov. 5:15-23** Rejoice with the wife of thy youth. Be satisfied and ravished with her love. **Prov. 18:22** Obtains favor with the Lord.
- c) Regarding frequency I Cor. 7:1-5
- 1) To avoid fornication.
- 2) Get married and give love to the marriage partner (vv. 2-3).
- 3) Don't live unto yourself (v. 4). Meet your partner's needs.
- 4) Don't defraud or rob the partner of what is rightfully his or hers (v. 5).
 - *Exception*: With mutual consent, for a time to fast & pray. Then come together again so Satan will not tempt.
- 5) The physical communication of married love becomes mechanical and animal unless the spiritual and psychological communication is first emphasized!
 - *Warning:* Keep the marriage boundary. With feelings, the line between the spiritual, emotional, and physical is very thin.
- d) Children are desirable **Ps. 127:3-5; 128:3**

Don't judge others on the number of children they have.

Childless couples: Let God answer your prayers (Matt. 21:22).

6. CHILDREN: Obey your parents - Eph. 6:1-3; I Tim. 6:1-6

- a) First commandment with promise (Ex. 20:12)
 - 1) Col. 3:20 Pleasing to the Lord
 - 2) **John 14:21** Shows love
- b) The remedy for disobedience:
 - 1) Under the law: *Death!* Ex. 21:15, 17; Deut. 21:18-21
 - 2) Under grace: Chasten! Heb. 12:7-9; Prov. 19:18
 - 3) How? With a rod Prov. 23:13-14; 22:15; 13:24; 3:11-12

7. FATHERS: Train your children – Eph. 6:4; Josh. 24:14-24

The father represents law & order. He also is a God image. Invest in your children your...

Time - Testimony - Training

(Demonstrate & seek to inculcate the following crucial things):

Salvation, Study the Word, Separation, Surrender, Soulwinning

- a) Prov. 22:6 Teach by creed and by deed. Who is teaching your children? TV? Ungodly schools? Friends & playmates?
- b) Isaiah 8:10 Teach them "line upon line, precept upon precept."
- c) **Prov. 4:1-2** Hear the father; he gives good doctrine

Prov. 8:13 – The *fear of the Lord* (**Prov. 1:8** – It's the beginning of *knowledge* & **Prov. 9:10** the beginning of *wisdom*)!

Deut. 6:6-7; II Tim. 1:5 – (Maintain) a family altar i.e. a family devotional time.

The Supreme Court decision ruled prayer and Bible study out of the public schools.

A father's neglect rules them out of the home!
